

Refresh, Revitalize, Renovate!

As announced last month, the library is planning to refresh some of our space in 2016. One area that

will be affected is the large meeting room on the first floor. The plan is to open it up and connect to the rest of the library by replacing the solid wall with a sliding glass door. This will allow increased seating capacity of the meeting room from approximately 80 to 132 seats. Windows will be added to the north wall to increase natural lighting and views of the haiku garden. New chairs and tables will be purchased to furnish this larger space.

Due to very careful stewardship of the library's reserve fund, the board is able to commit to finance almost three-quarters of the cost of the project from this fund. That leaves a shortfall that they're currently addressing.
