**Artist in Residence:** WWII Portrait Journey, an Odyssey Across America





Bainbridge Public Library visitors will be able to watch best-selling illustrator Chris Demarest paint on Saturdays beginning Oct. 1 through Nov. 30. The Kitsap Regional Library is hosting this Artist in Residence program, the first of its kind for our county library system.

Inspired by the black and white image of a WW II fighter pilot, Chris started a series of WW II portraits in 2011. Two years and 70 portraits later, he began traveling across the country to share his work. Watch Chris at the Bainbridge Library on Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. during October and November as he paints a portrait or bring your own WWII photo or memory to share. Changes come to us all, and especially to gardens. For 20 years, the Friday Tidy volunteers have planted and tended the BPL gardens, which kept growing in size as well as content. Many plants were donated as dozens of volunteers came and went, each bringing something special to the gardens. Today, most of the gardens need thorough editing, so this fall and winter, they will be renovated bed by bed. We're working toward more sustainable plantings that don't need as much managing to look attractive all year round.

This is a very common goal amongst gardeners, the younger folks since they are always pressed for time, the oldsters because we are slowing down. We'll reorganize the beds, add deeper mulches, and trade fussy perennials for hard working shrubs with several seasons of interest. We'll also be choosing theme plants that carry over from bed to bed, unifying the look and simplifying the care. If you are finding the care of your own landscape a bit overwhelming, keep an eye on our progress and you may find good ideas to transplant into your own gardens!
