

The Library Gazebo Needs Your Help!



The historic Bainbridge Public Library Gazebo needs critical repair for the safety of the patrons using it. This 20+ year old structure has serious rot on the roof and at the base of the eight pine poles supporting the gazebo. BPL has applied for a grant to Bainbridge Community Foundation's Community Grant Cycle to help pay for the repair and restoration of the gazebo. As part of the grant cycle, prospective grant recipients are asked to reach out to their supporters through Bainbridge Gives.
